



**RESOLUTION #140501  
TYRONE TOWNSHIP, LIVINGSTON COUNTY**

**BRIDGES AND HIGHWAYS; USE OF  
ORDINANCE. No. 2A**

Pursuant to the provision of Public Act 246, 1945, of the State of Michigan, as amended, for the purpose of securing the public peace, health, safety, welfare, and convenience of the people and property of Tyrone Township.

**Sec. 1. UNLOADING; MOVING; LAUNCHING; FISH-HOUSES;  
WATERCRAFT; UNLAWFUL.**

After the effective date of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to unload or move fish-houses or equipment of any kind, to launch boats or other watercraft of any kind or nature whatsoever from any public right-of-way in said Township of Tyrone into or onto any lake, river or stream or body of water bordering on such right-of-way.

**Sec. 2 FISHING; SWIMMING; ETC.; UNLAWFUL.**

After the effective date of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person or person to use any public bridge or right-of-way in said Township of Tyrone from which to fish, swim, or carry on other recreational activities in any lakes, rivers, streams or other body of water bordering on such right-of-way or flowing under such bridge.

**Sec. 3 PENALTIES.**

Any person who is convicted of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be issued a Municipal Civil Infraction and fined \$250.00.

**Sec. 4 EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This ordinance becomes effective 30 days after publication.


